Biked Up, Pedal Powered is a stunt-bike-dance-performance devised with the Brewery choreographers and musicians at Mintfest this September. The sound is pedal-powered by the audience on a Big Bike Power Pack which we will build in the summer. You can work with professionals to:

Create a media campaign

Build bike generators for the Big Bike Power Pack

Design and make set and costumes

Help choreograph a stunt-bike-dance

Compose the music

Help manage the event

Learn about fundraising and arts management

Design publicity materials

Recruit stunt-bikers for the dance

Steward on the day

### What can we offer you?

Supporting the project will be local volunteers from Creative Transition and staff from the Brewery Arts Centre and Mintfest.

Creative Transition is part of SLACctt which is a South Lakes group trying to slow climate change and create a better future.

Mentoring from specialists in the activities you volunteer for

## What do we need from you?

You need to be aged between 12 and 22 (although different roles need different ages) and have:

Commitment and energy

Some time over the summer

The ability to work with others

### From June...

There will be regular meetings as a group and with your mentor between June and September in Kendal, but depending on people's exam commitments. This is when all the planning and publicity will take place

### The week of 16 July...

Dance taster sessions will take place around Kendal the week of 16 July.

### The week of 27 August...

Production week, when the choreography, music composition, rehearsal, set and costume making will all take place, is the week of 27 August

## How do you sign up?

We have space for 16 young people to produce the event and Big Bike Power Pack, and for 20 bike dancers.
